### **Simufact Engineering starts new cooperation with AGH University of Science and Technology in Krakow**

**Krakow, Poland, September 17, 2012** - The AGH University of Science and Technology in Krakow (Poland) and Hamburg-based simulation software provider Simufact Engineering have agreed on a cooperation. Honourable Dean of Faculty for Metal Engineering and Industrial Computer Science of AGH, Prof. Mirosław Karbowniczek, and Michael Wohlmuth, Simufact CEO, have signed a Memorandum of Understanding to establish a partnership for common research and development projects.

The cooperation will be starting with a challenging project: The “AGH - Simufact Class”. Based on an initiative driven by Prof. Stefan Szczepanik, Professor for Materials Science at AGH Krakow, and Dr. Ralph Bernhardt, Director R&D at Simufact, next semester AGH will start with a student’s class for approx. 40 students. Core parts of the project are training sessions for the advanced usage of simulation software packages Simufact.forming and Simufact.welding. In special courses the students are also going to learn how to implement and validate their own models and additional functional expansions to the software.

Simufact will provide the necessary licenses and support training sessions at AGH.
